- b. Only the head of team is authorised to register, withdraw, make changes and pay the entry fees and penalties.
- c. Only Head of Team and Coaches are allowed to be at the competition area.
- d. Ratio: 5 Athletes to 1 Coach

14. Rights of the organiser:

- a. The organiser has the right to change the terms and conditions during the event.
- b. The organiser has the right to accept, reject and disqualify any athletes or clubs that do not abide with the terms and conditions of the outlines.

15. Liability:

- a. The organizer does not assume liability for any damages to persons or objects or for any losses.
- b. All participants and parents/legal guardians agree to the disclaimer of warranty by registration.
- c. Every participant, along with their parents/legal guardians, <u>MUST</u> possess their own accident and health coverage while participating in the championship.
- d. Additionally, all competitors and parents/legal guardians agree to the publication of their names in the results and to the use of photographs from the tournament and the award ceremony, including potential online publication.

16. Awards: ITMC 2024

Taekwondo MUSTANG would not participate in the scoring of the team medals.

Athlete's medals (all categories)

1st place – gold medal 2nd place – silver medal 3rd place – bronze medal 4th place – bronze medal

Team's Trophy – Kyorugi Team's Trophy – Poomsae, FS and Para

The following points would be added to award the winning teams.

Gold medal - 9 points Silver medal - 3 points

Bronze medal - 1 point (only the 3rd place)

Only those categories with competitors are taken into consideration. For example:

Gold medal – minimum 2 starters Silver medal – minimum 3 starters Bronze medal – minimum 4 starters

The medals from the Vorarlberg Taekwondo Open Championship are not included in the ITMC Team's Trophy.

17. Awards: Vorarlberg Taekwondo Open Championship (Medals)

- a. The Vorarlberg Taekwondo Open Championship will take place simultaneously with the International Taekwondo Mustang Championship.
- b. The top three athletes from Vorarlberg in Class A and B will be awarded with medals.
- c. This rule applies only to athletes from Vorarlberg who possess a Vorarlberg Taekwondo Pass with a valid signature from the president of VTDV.
- d. A valid Vorarlberg Taekwondo Pass includes the annual ÖTDV stickers and it has to be shown during the registration.
- e. These medals are not included in the ITMC Team's Trophy

Athlete's medals (Kyorugi, Poomsae, Para and Freestyle)

1st place – gold medal 2nd place – silver medal 3rd place – bronze medal

18. Titles: Vorarlberg Taekwondo Open Championship

- a. Rules apply as mentioned above.
- b. The first athlete from Vorarlberg in each Class A will be awarded the title "Vorarlberger Landesmeister" along with a gold medal.
- c. The first athlete from Vorarlberg in each Class B will be awarded the title "Vorarlberger Nachwuchsmeister" along with a gold medal.
- d. The above-mentioned titles apply to all categories in Poomsae & FS single, pair, team and in Kyorugi.

26. Competition mode:

a. Two Patterns in the final round.

b. All competitors can choose the patterns from their individual pool.

c. Class A athletes could choose any **two forms** from their respective table, but they must choose at least **one DAN** form.

d. Class B could choose any two forms from their respective table. No repeats possible.

e. Class C athletes can repeat the forms from 1st Taeguk.

27. Classes: Class A - 1st - 2nd KUP, POOM, DAN

Class B - 3rd - 8th KUP
Class C - 9th - 10th KUP
*No mixture between the classes.

28. Pair: Class A – male/female

Class B and C — any combinations

*Athletes can only compete once in each category.

29. Team: Class A – male/male/male, female/female/female

Class B and C — any combinations
*Athletes can only compete once in each category.

30. Age combination:

Athletes from **respective** classes **COULD** form a pair or team with different **age** group! But they must compete in the **highest** age group and perform the **self-chosen** Poomsae for that **age** group. For example:

If a 29-year-old female teams with a 15-year-old female and a 14-year-old female, they must compete in "under 31" class and all three should be able to perform the self-selected patterns from "under 31". (Taegeuk 4 – Pyongwon)

34. Family Poomsae:

- a. Regardless of ages, categories and grades, all athletes are to perform **two** self-selected recognized WT Poomsae in the **finals**.
- b. The patterns are ${f not}$ allowed to be repeated, except for the ${\bf 9}^{th}$ and ${\bf 10}^{th}$ KUP athletes.
- c. Family Poomsae is open for all siblings, parents, grandparents, aunts and uncles.
- d. Coaches/Trainers and their athletes could start in this category. (TKD Family)
- e. The pairs and teams would start in the eldest member age category.

For example:

If a 52-year-old coach/trainer would start with his 19-year-old athlete, they would start in "51 and above" age category.

- b) Medals would be awarded to the top three participants from each age and gender group who finished the fastest.

40. Disclaimer and Waiver of Liability:

- a) The organising committee of the Taekwondo Mustang-Feldkirch must not be held responsible for any injury sustained during the tournament. The competitors understand and accept all risks taken by registering for the competition.
- b) By registering and participating in the International Taekwondo Mustang Championship 2024 and/or the Vorarlberg Taekwondo Open Championship 2024, competitors agree that they participate at their own risk.
- c) In the case of minors, the club or the person carrying out the registration ensures that the consent of the parents/legal guardian has been obtained.
- d) Competitors accept civil and criminal liability for any damage caused during the event (personal injury, property damage and consequential damage).
- e) The competitors waive any claims against the organiser and its appointed members and other vicarious agents in connection of any damaging incidents that occur during (direct or indirect connection with) the event "International Taekwondo Mustang Championship 2024 and / or the Open Vorarlberg National Championship 2024".
- f) This waiver is also declared for relatives and dependants. The competitors also indemnify the organiser TAEKWONDO MUSTANG-FELDKIRCH against claims by third parties.
- g) By registering, competitors expressly declare that they are in good health (medical certificate) and that they have taken out sufficient liability accident and health insurance cover valid in Austria.
- h) Competitors agree that pictures and film recordings made during the event may be published on websites and in printed matter and that their name may be included on lists of participants.
- i) With the application / registration, all competitors accept the organiser's conditions of participation according to the announcement, to be aware of all dangers and risks during participation in the INTERNATIONAL TAEKWONDO MUSTANG CHAMPIONSHIP 2024 and / or the VORARLBERG TAEKWONDO OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP 2024 and to fully accept all points mentioned in this disclaimer.
